- Instruct students by lecturing, demonstrating, and using audiovisual aids and other materials to complement lesson plans
- Design a variety of activities to engage students in active learning
- Develop written lesson plans and activities by using a variety of instructional materials and techniques and to meet the needs of the students
- Establish high expectations for student performance and provide motivation, management, instruction, guidance, and support to assist students to meet those expectations.
- Direct and evaluate the learning experience of the students in both curricular and extra-curricular activities
- Plan and organize instruction to best meet the needs of each individual student
- Manage the classroom to create optimal learning conditions
- Provide guidance to students which will promote their welfare and proper educational development
- Provide leadership to students by modeling good citizenship and a positive attitude toward learning
- Assess and report student progress in a timely manner
- Maintain a professional relationship with parents and the community
- Participate in professional development activities

- Supervise students in and out of the classroom while on duty
- Initiate and maintain communication and a good working relationship with colleagues, students and parents
- Attend meetings and serve on committees as requested
- Have thorough knowledge of CAVIAT JTED policies that pertain to instruction and student discipline
